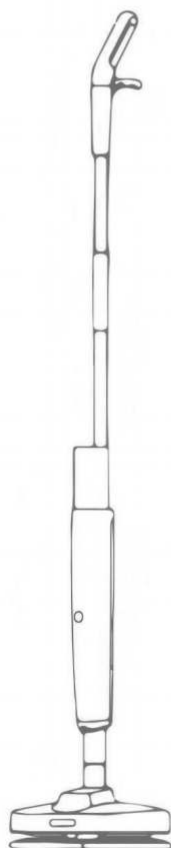

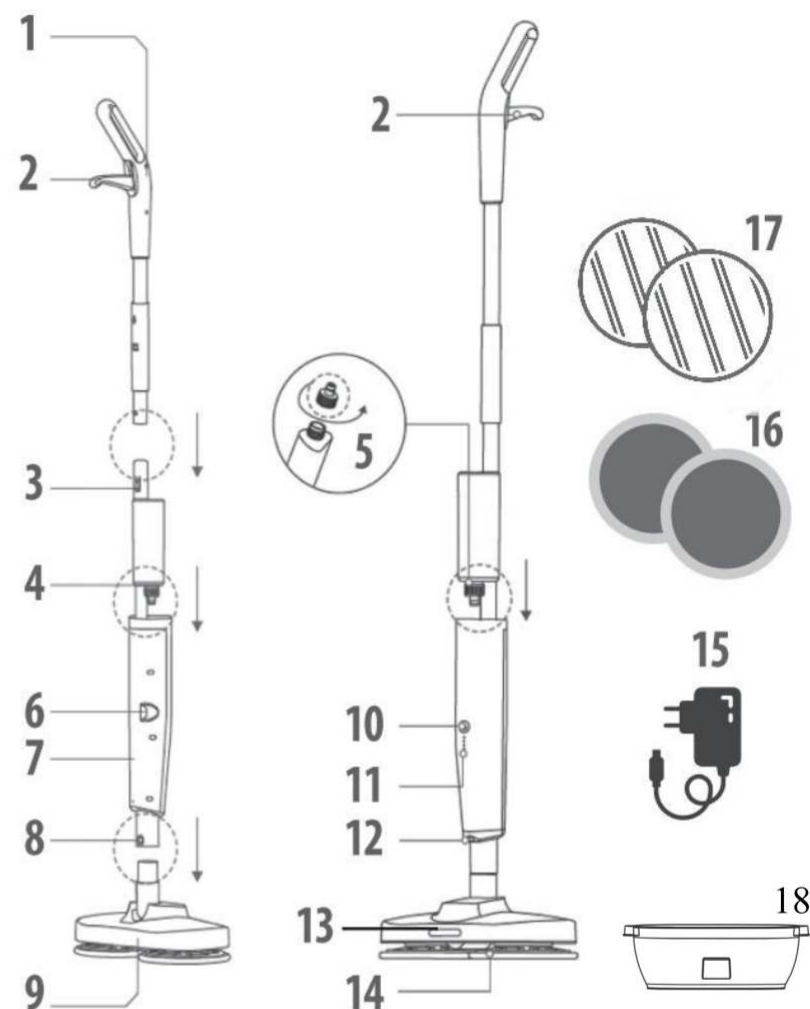

SAFETY

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS ON SAFETY OF USE PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE!

- By ignoring the safety instructions the manufacturer can not be hold responsible for the damage.
- Never move the appliance by pulling the cord and make sure the cord can not become entangled.
- This appliance is only to be used for household purposes and only for the purpose it is made for.
- To protect yourself against an electric shock, do not immerse the cord, plug or appliance in the water or any other liquid.
- Make sure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to the local mains voltage before plugging in.

CHILD SAFETY:

This appliance should not be used by children under 8 years of age. This appliance can only be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they are supervised or understand the hazards and instructions concerning use of the appliance in a safe way. Children should not play with the device. Keep the device and cord out of the reach of children under 8 years old. Cleaning and maintenance should not be done by children unless they are over 8 years old and under supervision.

DEVICE SAFETY

- Switch off the appliance and disconnect from supply before changing accessories or approaching parts that move in use.
- Avoid contact with moving parts. Keep hands, hair, clothing, as well as spatulas and other utensils away from attachments and mixing container during operation to reduce risk of injury to persons, and/or damage to the appliance.
- The power cable should be plugged into an electrical outlet away from sink or hot surface.
- Do not operate a damaged power cable. Replace damaged power cable immediately.

BEFORE THE FIRST USE

- Take the appliance and accessories out the box. Remove the stickers, protective foil or plastic from the device.
- Before using your appliance for the first time, wipe off all removable parts with a damp cloth. Never use abrasive products.
- Put the power adaptor cable into the socket (Note: Make sure the voltage which is indicated on the device matches the local voltage before connecting the device Voltage 100V-240V 50/60Hz)

CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

- The lights will be flashing indicate the unit is charging. When fully charged, all lights turns off. Do not use the device during charging.
- The device is fully charged after 3-5hours and can then be used effectively.
- During charging, it is normal for the body of the device to heat up.
- When the last light flashing means low power.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision. The supply cord cannot be replaced. If the cord is damaged the appliance should be scrapped.
- Warning: Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

USE

For turning device press On/Off button. Device start working. Pre-moisten the area to be cleaned using the water spray button. After cleaning turn off device press to On/Off button.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Always remove the plug from the socket when the device will be cleaned.
- Clean the appliance with a damp cloth. Never use harsh and abrasive cleaners, scouring pad or steel wool, which damages the device.
- Never immerse the electrical device in water or any other liquid.
- Cleaning and polishing cloths are suitable for washing in the washing machine.

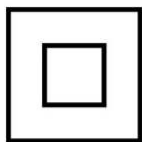

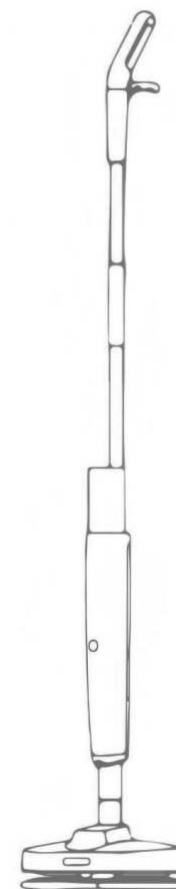
